## 1. His gifts reveal God's purpose for my life.

✓ <u>Develop</u> my gifts.

## 3. His gifts make the difference for others.

God has given each of you a gift from his great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another. (1 Peter 4:10, NLT)

✓ <u>Use</u> my gifts.

All of you together are the one body of Christ, and each one of you is a separate and necessary part of it. (1 Corinthians 12:27, LB)
